## The Healthcare Facilities Symposium & Expo Mobile App

Elevate your experience! Search for sessions, build your schedule, find exhibitors, and network with fellow attendees. 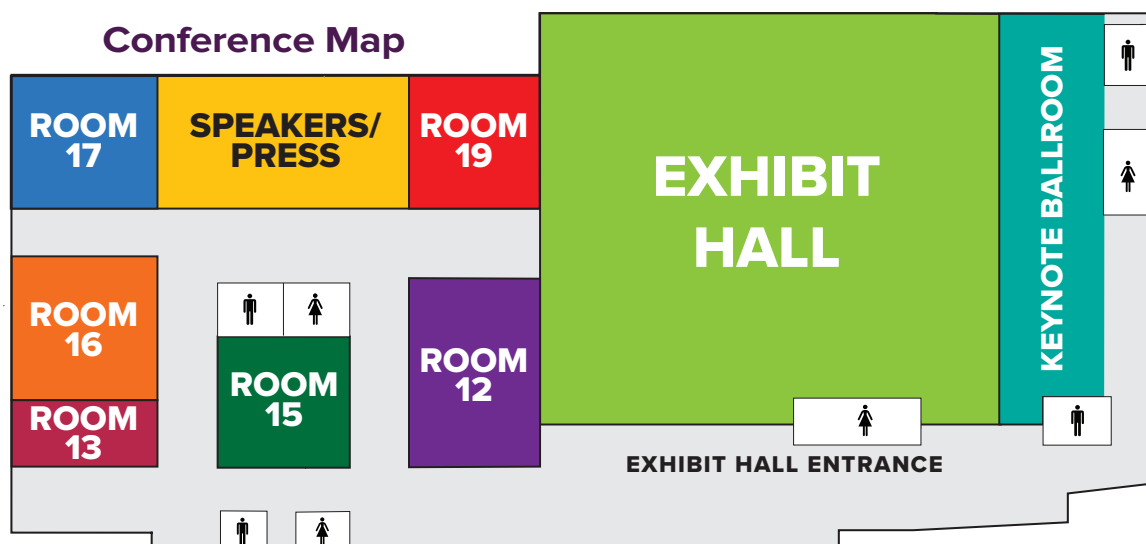

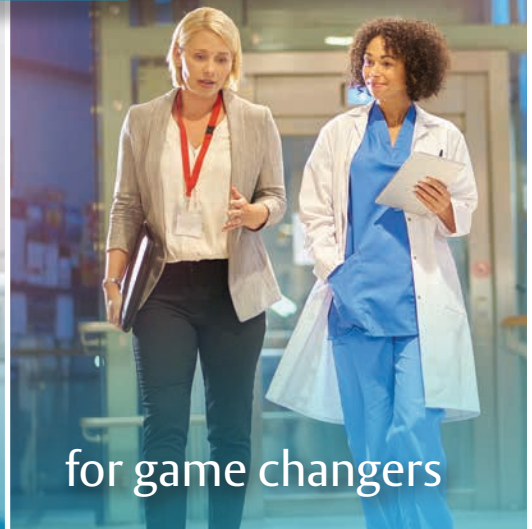

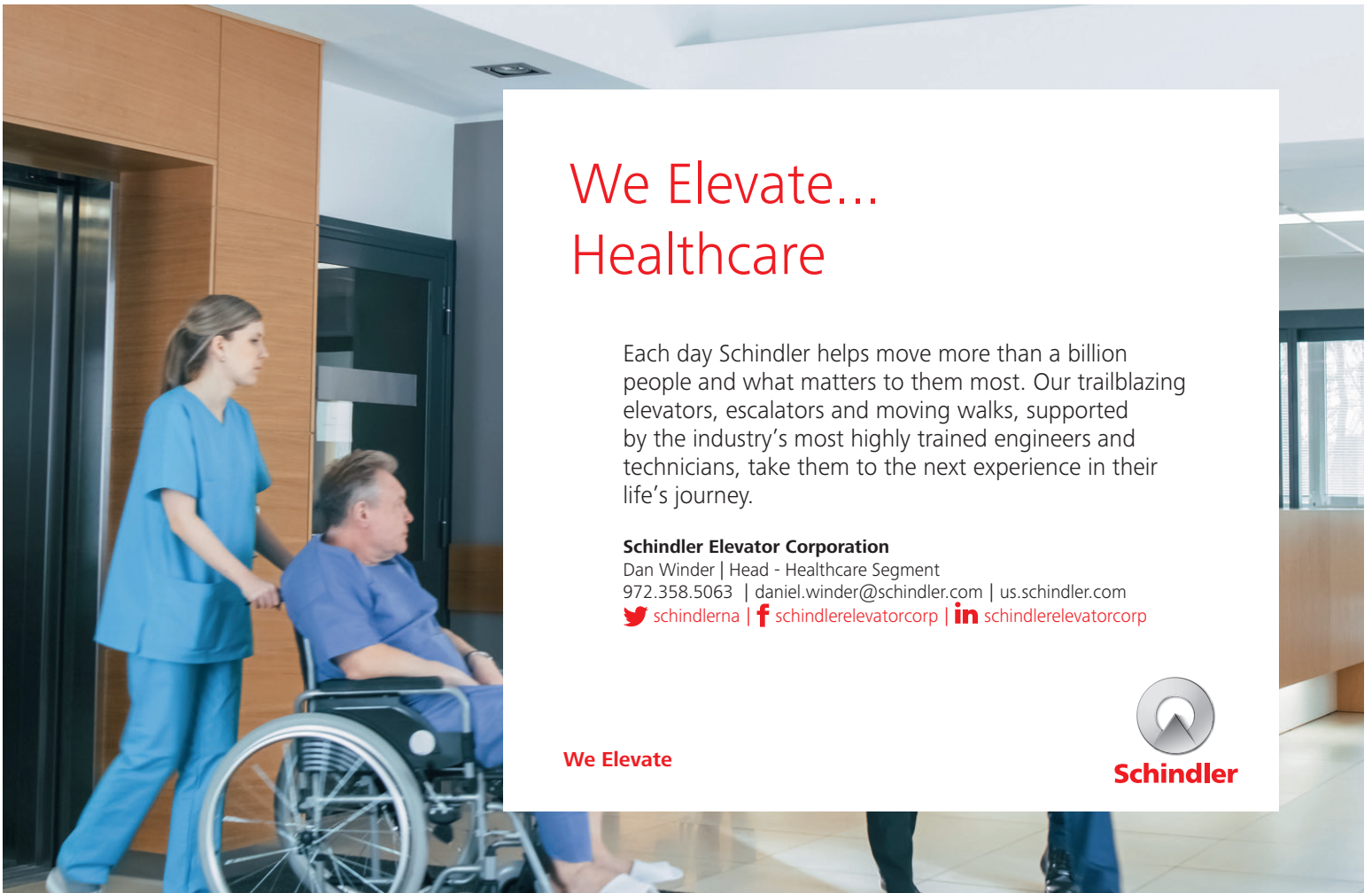
