## The Healthcare Facilities Symposium & Expo Mobile App

Elevate your experience! Search for sessions, build your schedule, find exhibitors, and network with fellow attendees. Search the app store for JD Events and download the JD Events Show App. Launch the app and then select Healthcare Facilities Symposium & Expo 2022. For Android and iPhone devices. ### Here's how to get started ...

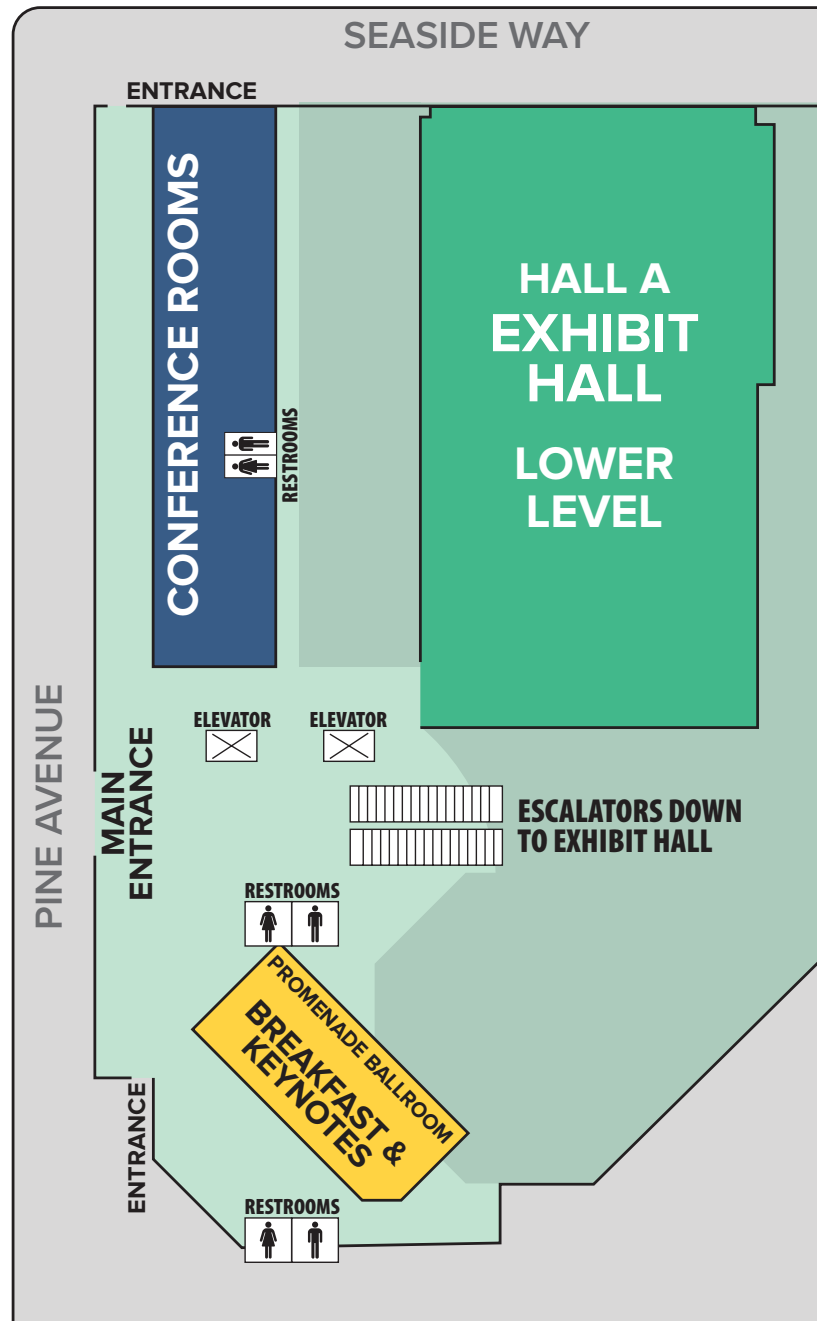
